### Fusion Liaison Officer “FLO” Basic Course

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course is a prerequisite for being a Fusion Liaison Officer (FLO). The course will train students in the information sharing intelligence-gathering mission, which is crucial to the war on terrorism and organized criminal activity.

- Understand the organizational structure of the intelligence community.
- Demonstrate the role/mission of the Idaho Criminal Intelligence Center.
- Explain the proper handling of sensitive information, UNCLASSIFIED//FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY//LAW ENFORCEMENT SENSITIVE.
- Illustrate domestic and international terrorist groups ideologies and methods of executing terrorist acts.
