1. Closed Campus Exemption Request

Victor McCraw stated IDAPA Rule 11.11.01.071.01 requires POST Basic Patrol Academies to be closed campus. The rule further states that the POST Council may consider an exemption to that requirement on a case-by-case basis. He requested the Council's permission to run the next three patrol academies as open campus. The specific sessions are #184 which begins September 13, 2015; #185 which begins January 3, 2016; and #186 which begins March 27, 2016.

Lorin Nielsen made a motion to run POST Basic Patrol Academies #184, #185, and #186 as open campus academies. Wayne Rausch seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Lorin Nielsen made a motion to adjourn. Jan Bennetts seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.
