DISORDERLY CONDUCT AND ASSEMBLY

Disturbing the Peace

- a) Maliciously and willfully disturbs the peace of any neighborhood, family or person, by loud or unusual noise, or by tumultuous or offensive conduct, or by threatening, traducing, quarreling, challenging to fight or fighting, or fires any gun or pistol, or uses vulgar, profane or indecent language within the presence or hearing of children, in a loud and boisterous manner. M 18-6409(1)
- b) Maliciously and willfully disturbs the dignity or reverential nature of any funeral, memorial service, funeral procession, burial ceremony or viewing of a deceased person..... M 18-6409(2)

Alcohol Beverage Control - Common Violation Checklist

OFFICERS MAY INSPECT PREMISE – IC 23-930

Any law enforcement officer in the State of Idaho has the right, at any time, to examine a premise that has an alcohol beverage license. The purpose of the premise examination is to check for compliance of the laws, rules, regulations and local ordinances that pertain to licensed establishments.

OVER SERVICE - IC 23-615

Patrons displaying obvious, apparent or actual signs of intoxication should be stopped from further alcohol consumption by employees/bartenders.

During investigation and report writing, include the following:

- Document visible and all other signs of intoxication, get BAC if possible.
- Get statement from subject and anybody they are with at the bar.
- What time did they get to the bar?
- What time did they leave?
- What were they drinking?
- How many drinks?
- How did they pay?
- Get copies of receipts.
- What bartender served them?
- Did they drink anywhere else before or after?
- Identify bartender and get statement.
- Send reports to ABC for administrative action.

AFTER HOURS SERVICE/CONSUMPTION – BEER IC 23-1012, LIQUOR IC 23-927

Alcohol cannot be dispensed after 0100 hours. Cities/counties may extend this time by 1 hour, until 0200 hours. Check your local ordinances. Patrons then have 30 minutes to consume beverages served. After 30 minutes, open beverages have to be behind the bar and disposed of.

During investigation and report writing, include the following:

- Watch through windows for violations if possible prior to entry.
- The laws also apply to bar staff serving themselves.
- Get statement from subject and anybody they are with at the bar.
- Identify the type of alcoholic drink.
- Identify bartender and get statement.
- Photograph all evidence.
- Send reports to ABC for administrative action.

UNLOCKED LIQUOR CABINETS - IC 23-927

Open liquor containers must be locked by 0100 hours and can't be unlocked until 1000 hours. Cities/counties may extend this time by 1 hour, until 0200 hours. Check your local ordinances.

During investigation and report writing, include the following:

- Unsealed liquor bottles must be securely locked in a room or using a locking device, making them irremovable and secured.
- Watch through windows for violations if possible prior to entry.
- Identify the type of unlocked liquor bottles.
- Identify bartender and get statement.
- Photograph all evidence.
- Send reports to ABC for administrative action.

FAILURE TO DEFACE GOVERNMENT OR STATE STAMPS – IC 23-926

Immediately when empty, the employee/bartender shall deface the yellow ISLD stamp located on liquor bottles. The defacing can be completed by marker, pen, scratching middle of the stamp or other reasonable means.

During investigation and report writing, include the following:

- Ask bartender to see all empty liquor containers.
- Identify bartender and get statement.
- Photograph all evidence.
- Look for signs of illegal liquor re-pouring:
 - Multiple bottles of same liquor with broken seals; funnels; large ½ gallon or ¾ liter bottles in bar or dumpster; out-of place bottles in back rooms; worn bottle labels; drip marks on bottles.
- Send reports to ABC for administrative action.

SELLING/PROVIDING ALCOHOL TO A MINOR – IC 23-615

No person shall sell, dispense, give away or allow people under 21 YOA to consume any alcohol beverages.

** IC 23-1023 does not allow consumption in private residence.*

During investigation and report writing, include the following:

- Ask minor where they purchased or received the alcohol.
- Check minor's identification.
- Check minor for fake identification.
- Get statement from minor and anybody they are with.
- Interview clerk/bartender at establishment where alcohol came from.
- Get copies of receipts.
- Check surveillance video.
- Photograph all evidence.
- Send reports to ABC for administrative action.

SOURCE INVESTIGATION

Source Investigation is a tool used by ABC to find the source of alcoholic beverages. Source Investigation can be a valuable tool during many aspects of law enforcement including motor vehicle crashes; domestic violence; assaults/batteries; and underage parties. Licensees and other individuals can be held accountable for dispensing alcohol to certain individuals, such as minors and over-served patrons. During investigation and report writing, include the following:

- Identify if alcohol has been consumed, or may have been consumed.
- Gather receipts, empty containers, boxes and other pertinent evidence.
- Identify all parties involved and get statements.
- Photograph all evidence.
- Contact your local ABC Detective ASAP for follow-up investigation and assistance.
 - ABC Source Investigation will include interviews; video surveillance and gathering financial records.
- Send reports to ABC for administrative action.

Please fax or mail all completed alcohol violation reports to Alcohol Beverage Control.

If sufficient evidence exists through reports and ABC follow-up investigation, administrative action will be taken against the licensee. Penalties start at 10 day alcohol license suspension or \$1,000 fine for a 1st offense. Mitigating or aggravating circumstances will also be taken into consideration for proposed penalties.
