Fusion Liaison Officer “FLO” - Intermediate

**April 29th & 30th, 2014 0800-1700 hours in Boise
(Boise Police Department)**

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is being presented through the State of Idaho’s Fusion Center, the Idaho Criminal Intelligence Center([IC]²). **Student must have completed the FLO Basic Course prior to attending the FLO Intermediate course.**

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Provide an intermediate level of understanding of the FLO mission and to the broader threat of terrorism, along with more extensive mastering of the tactics, techniques and procedures needed to better preform the roles and responsibilities of a FLO.
- To educate certified FLOs in key concepts of intelligence, networking, terrorist group’s infrastructures, red team methodology and emerging threats corresponding to better conducting the FLO mission.
- To identify domestic, transnational, single-issue, and international terrorist groups, movements, ideologies, objectives and methods of executing terrorist acts.

COURSE LENGTH: 16 Hours

TARGET AUDIENCE/DISCIPLINE: This instruction is designed for patrol, investigative, and jail personnel who are functioning as a FLO for their organization
