CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

The course material for the Command College will be patterned after course material in the Law Enforcement Executive and Development Seminar (LEEDS) held at the FBI Academy. The Intermountain Command College will target (but not be limited to) managers from agencies with 10 to 50 sworn personnel. The minimum rank required to attend the Command College is Lieutenant. However, consideration will be given to Sergeants if their department provides a written request justifying attendance based on the Sergeant's management responsibilities, such as development of departmental policy, supervision of subordinates, and/or command-level decisions. Sergeant applications received without written appeal will not be considered. A committee consisting of representatives from the sponsoring agencies will be responsible for selecting participants based on their submitted application.

Applications received after the March 12 deadline will not be considered.
