- ➔ Promote the safety of officers and civilians.
- ➔ Increase officer understanding of mental illness.
- ➔ Improve relationships with the community, particularly with mental health professionals, people with mental illness and their families.
- ➔ Provide officers with de-escalation skills to assist individuals with serious mental illness to reduce trauma and keep people in crisis out of jail.

CIT is conducted by specially trained law enforcement personnel, mental health professionals, mental health consumers and family advocates. The training includes identification of types of mental illness, verbal skills for de-escalation of potentially violent situations, specifics on suicide intervention and a mental health system overview.
