To be eligible, the applicant shall have served in the military as a full time military law enforcement officer for the period of time which the credit is requested. The period must have been for one year or more. Regular guard duty does not qualify. **No time will be awarded for military time that occurred after an officer was hired by an Idaho law enforcement agency.**

POST Credit:

1 year of accepted military law enforcement service = 3 months law enforcement experience credit.
8 hours accepted military law enforcement training = 4 hours law enforcement training credit.

**No applicant shall be awarded more than two (2) years of law enforcement experience.
No applicant shall be awarded more than one thousand (1,000) hours of law enforcement training.**
