This program covers ways to look at self-perceptions and perceptions of the community in an accountable way. This allows open, honest, communication, while removing judgements and improving relations within our communities.

This course offers another way to look at communication and relations by focusing on:

- Accountability
- Trust Perceptions
- Judgment/Connection

Who Should Attend- This course is designed for all law enforcement professionals from the Chief of Police/Sheriff to patrol officer/deputy, both active and retired.
