

Student Information Sheet
Firearms Instructor Course

1. This is a five day (40 hour) course hosted by POST. Your attendance is required for the entire 40 hours to receive credit for this course. There will be a POST roster distributed on the last day for you to sign.
2. The hours for the class will be from 0800-1700 hrs. per day except on Wednesday when hours are altered to accommodate a night shoot. Tardiness will not be accepted. Lunches will be 45 minutes per day and will also be used for travel time. The course will conclude on Friday at approximately 1230 hrs.
3. Students will be expected to dress in clothing appropriate for weather conditions. Range clothing should consist of clothing conducive to the carry of extra ammunition. Clothing should be suitable for tactical movement. Knee pads are recommended but not required. Shorts, and open toe shoes, are not permitted.
4. **This is an instructor course, so all attendees should be able to meet the POST instructor qualification standards of 95% on the POST short course. Anything outside of the silhouette, (in the white or off the target), is an automatic Do-Not-Qualify. Rounds not fired within course time limits is a Do-Not-Qualify unless the shooter has a malfunction which they PROPERLY clear (running out of ammunition DOES NOT COUNT as a malfunction) Attendees will be given three opportunities to pass this test on the first day at the range. Students failing to meet the Post instructor standard on the first day will not be allowed to attend the rest of the school.**
5. In order to successfully complete this course each student will be expected to demonstrate safe gun handling skills, complete gun handling techniques within given time parameters from the class skills sheet, participate in teaching segments during the week, and successfully complete several additional and diverse qualification courses. Students must score an 80% or higher on a written exam.
6. **In addition students will have to qualify out on Friday with the same scoring criteria on the POST short course. If the student fails to qualify out they will not receive the completion certificate. Failing students will have to retake, and successfully pass, the entire course to apply for certification.**
6. Students will be required to bring the following:
 - Eye and ear protection.
 - A billed cap of some type.
 - Duty leather, holster, magazine pouches.
 - Duty handgun and a minimum of 4 magazines.
 - 1,000 rounds of practice ammunition for duty weapon
 - Duty flashlight
 - Ballistic Vest (if available)
 - Laptop Computer
 - Notepad (Instruction material will be provided)
