

# Cell Extraction Instructor Course

May 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021

This course will give Detention/Correctional Officers, at an instructor level, the tools to instruct fellow officers on how to perform a Planned Action Cell Extraction involving 1 to 2 offenders by:

- Correctly demonstrating defensive tactics used during a cell extraction
- Participating in Cell Extraction scenarios and correctly demonstrating the responsibilities of each role assumed.
- Correctly entering a cell, controlling a disruptive offender, restraining, and escorting the disruptive offender, and performing a controlled release in a safe and secure manner.
- Don/Doff Protective Equipment, and properly clean and store equipment.
- **Students will be expected to actively participate in high levels of physical exertion during cell extraction scenarios.**

*Attending this course does not qualify you to instruct others to become instructors! This is an end-user instructor course!*
