AR15/M4 (Unbranded) Armorer Course

Detailed disassembly and reassembly to emphasize operation and the actual function of a direct impingement weapon. Class is 90% hands on from start to finish, with consistent emphasis on inspection of parts and the diagnostics associated with wear and failure. Class will cover:

- Nomenclature and Design Cycle
- Ammunition Cleaning and Maintenance
- Troubleshooting Malfunctions/Diagnostics
- Parts Inspection and Common Failures
- Basic Field Strip
- Detailed Disassembly/Reassembly
- Repair Documentation for the Departmental Armorer

This AR15/M4 Armorer class is unbranded and relevant to all AR manufacturers. TTG carbines will be utilized for this class to prevent small parts loss or damage from occurring with duty weapons. Students are welcome to bring tools to class, however tools necessary to complete class will be provided for use in class, as well as support materials.
