Description: Defensive Tactics ARCON Instructor

Peace Officer Standard Training (POST) and the Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections (IDJC) are partnering to host an ARCON (Arrest and Control) Training to staff working in the juvenile justice field. This is the new P.O.ST. approved Defensive Tactic Course using the ARCON curriculum. This training course includes a test-in component, skills training, teach-back, and skills test-out component.
